

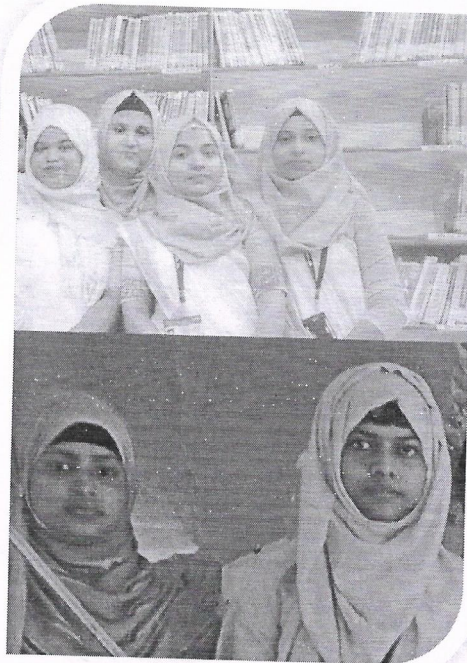

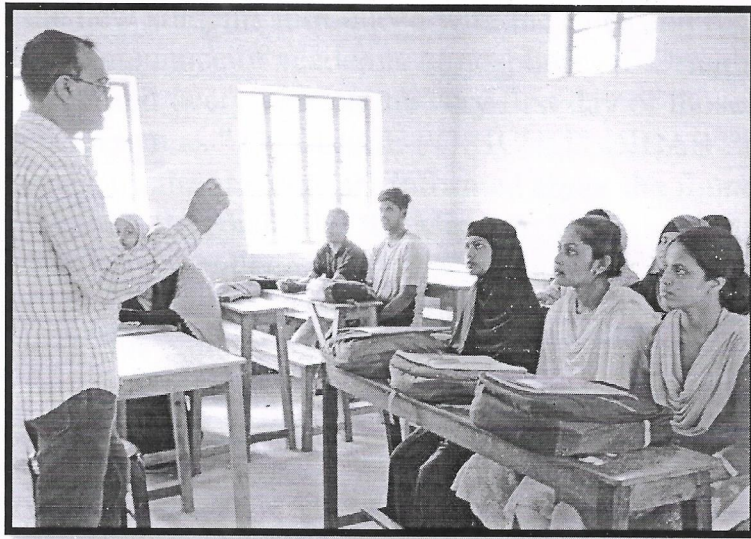
1.3 Curriculum Enrichment

1.3.1 Institution integrates crosscutting issues relevant to professional Ethics , Gender, Human Values, Environment and Sustainability in transacting the Curriculum

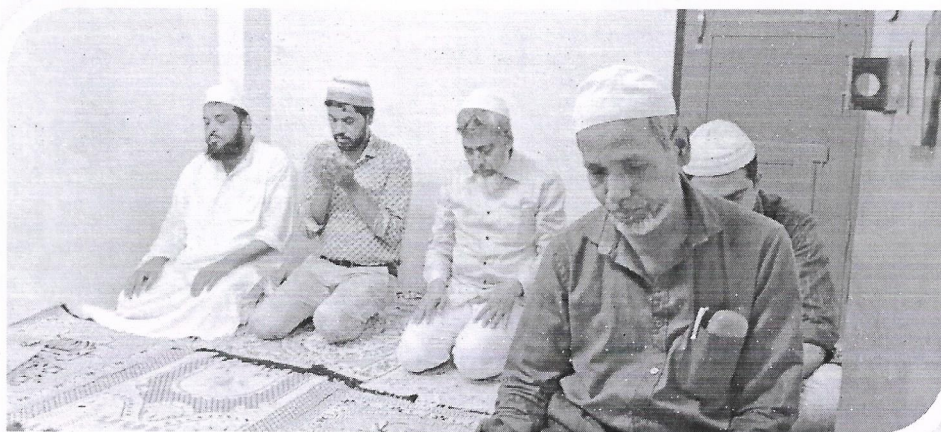

Observing Hizab by of our girls students

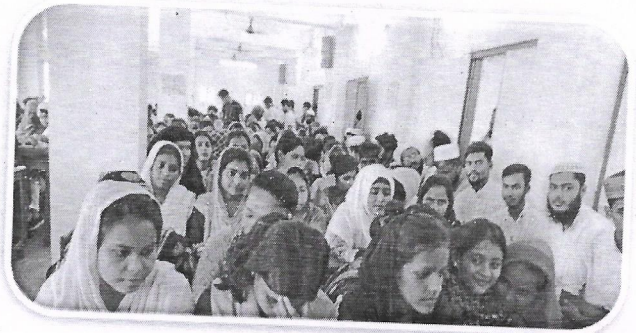
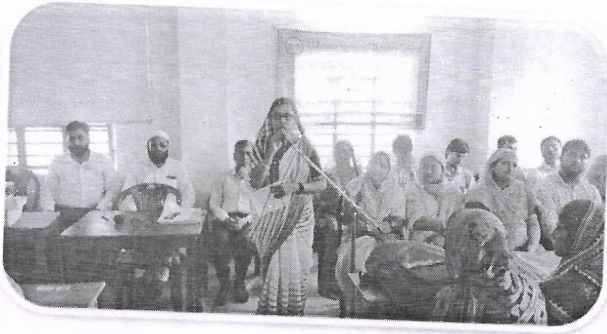
