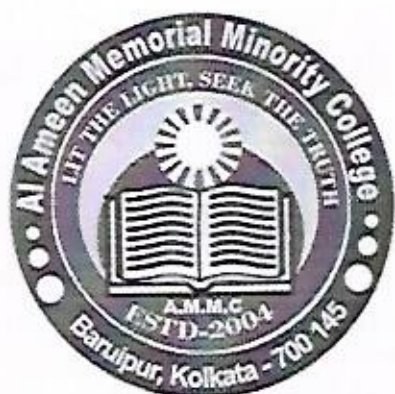

The college unit actively participates in various national and state level camps and programs. Some of the activities include :

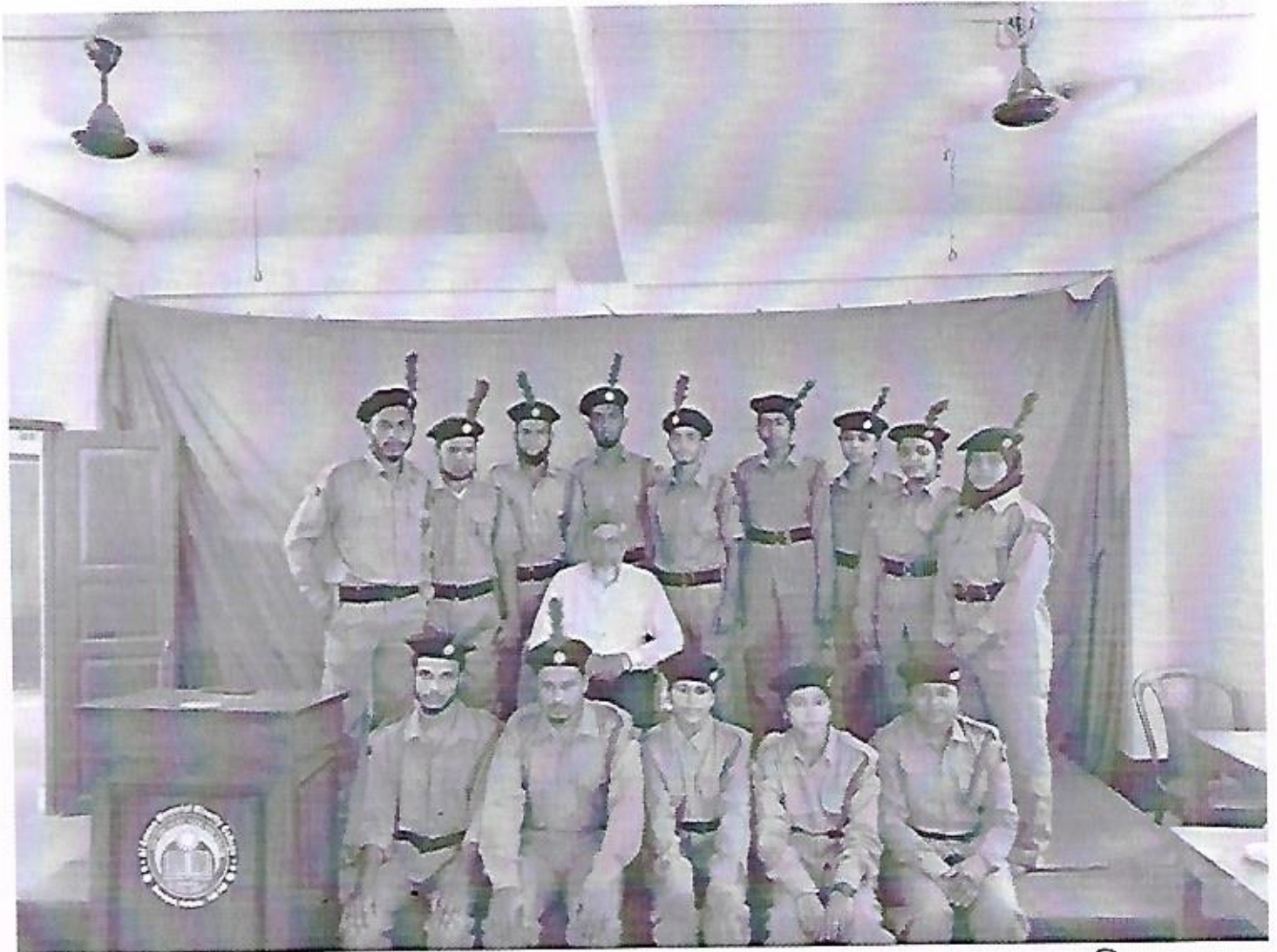

MOTTO :

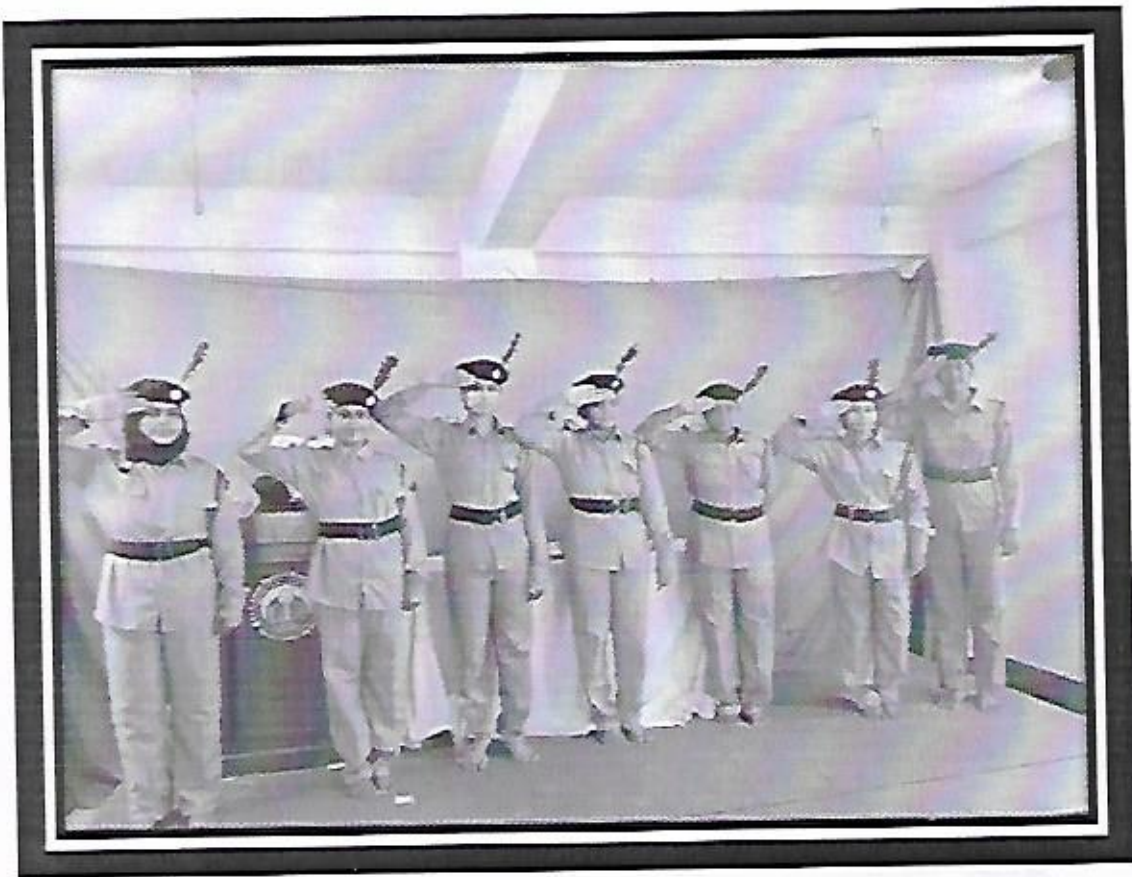

OBJECTIVE :

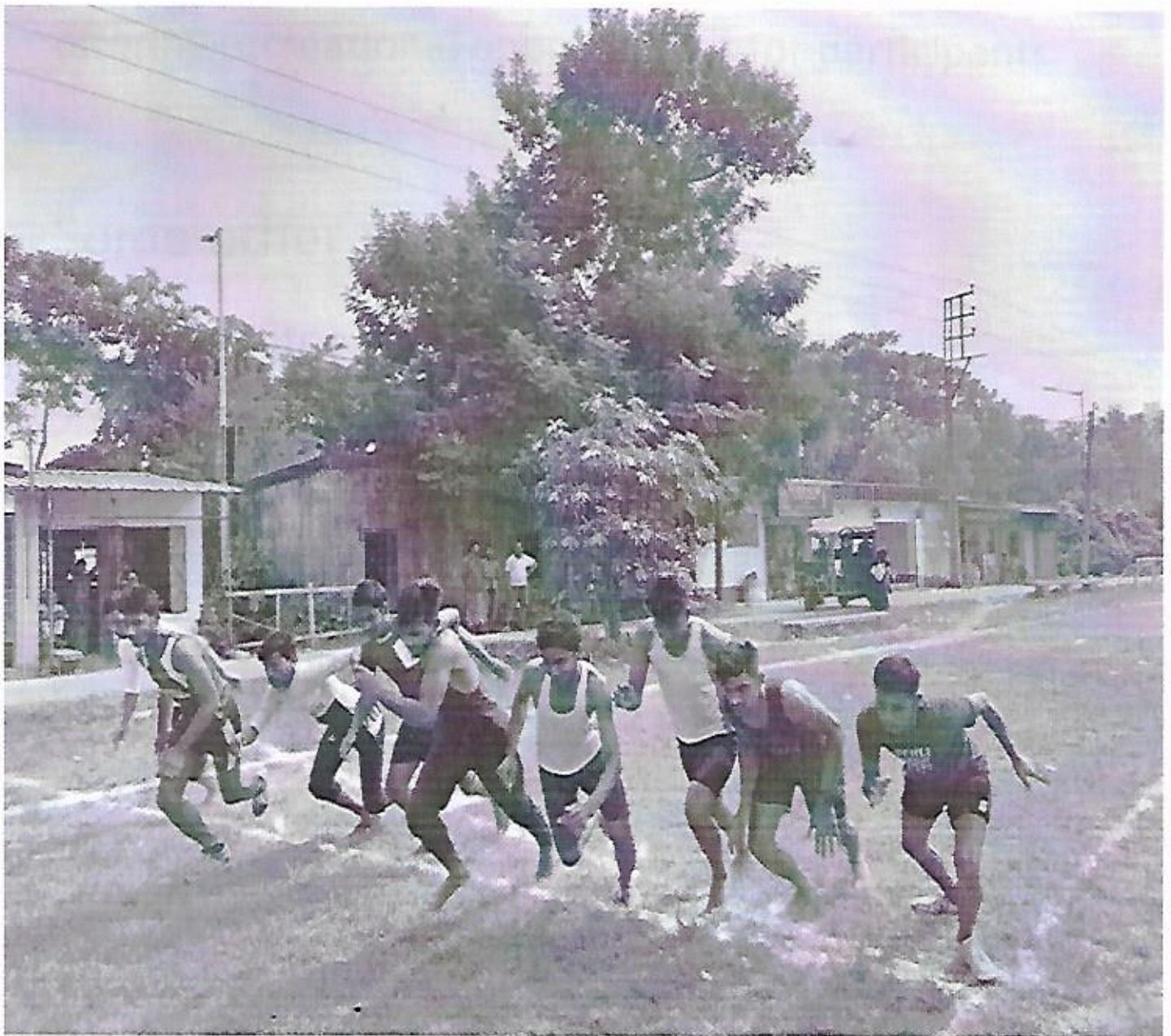
