

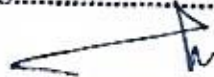

## Article 1

### OBJECTIVE OF COLLABORATION

## Article 3

### FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

Any collaboration under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval of the relevant authorities.

## Article 4

### LOCATION OF ACTIVITIES

- The Parties agree to implement the programmes stated in Article 2 at Al-Ameen Memorial Minority College and Surendranath Evening College.
- Any changes of the location of the programmes shall be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

### MODE OF CONDUCTING THE PROGRAMMES


The programmes will be conducted in blended mode (offline and online).

**Article 7**

**DURATION AND TERMINATION**

- 1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.


