5) The teachers, Staff and Studente are very careful of wastage of electricity, and therefore, they switch off fans, lights, etc. immediatly after the assigned works are done.



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
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Smoking-Free Zone :-



ii . Baruipur Rajbari

The traditional Rajbari of Baruipur is centuries old. If you look at the history of Baruipur, it is known that Zamidar Rajballab Chowdhury got a large area as dowry from the then Nawab. The Chowdhury family later acquired the title of Roy Chowdhury. King Rajvallabh Roy Chowdhury built a palatial palace by giving it to a foreign company during the reign of Lord Cornwallis. Thirteen Parbans in the twelve months of Bengali. Almost every one of them was celebrated royally. From Durga Puja to Rath Yatra - nothing is left out.







iii . Mahaprabhutla (Baruipur Puratan Bazar)

Sri Chaitanyadev went to Nilachal after taking sannyas. He was going to Baruipur by boat through the adi Ganges. On the way, Antisara Mahaprabhu came to the house of disciple Ananta Acharya. Stayed for three days. Rath also inaugurated the festival. This information was given by Nityananda Das Babaji, the current head of Mahaprabhu Tala.

The 500-year-old Rath festival is still being celebrated in Sambar. Even on Rath Day, people from far and wide come to enjoy khichuri under Mahaprabhu. The Mahaprabhu temple still has the shoes of Lord Chaitanya. Lord Mahaprabhu is worshiped here. Gaura and Nitai idols were also made under his orders during Sri Chaitanya's reign.Nityananda Das Babaji, head of the temple, said that when Chaitanya Dev came here, Ananta Acharya's house was a thatched cottage. Then there is thatched house. From there, the temple has improved over time. The festival is still being held according to tradition. Now the chariot comes out from the old market junction. Parikrama ends at Bhattacharya Para. There Harinam Sankirtan. Here all people irrespective of caste creed have free entry.





iv. Kachari Bazar Jame Masjid

It is located right next to Chayasree Gali near Baruipur Kachari Bazar. Its current imam Mahamudul Hasan Sk says that daily prayers are offered according to the rules. And hundreds of people come here to offer prayers as well. All people can come here irrespective of caste religion caste. 


v. Sent Cathedral Baruipur (Bishop House)
