

The World Water Day makes aware of the global water crisis, and a core focus of the observance of it is to make people aware of the necessity of preserving drinking water.






World Water Day March 22 ,2022

Hence, to encourage awareness and action to protect our environment, an innovative concept was adopted by the department to bring in awareness among all the students from all the streams by administering oaths in their respective




Classes. Various flowering plants like Aleo vera, Fasmira, Mili plant, Wayantara, Rangan etc. were provided by the department of Environment Studies.

At end of the event, food packet were distributed for the students.


