Policy For Scholarships/Freeships to students of Al Ameen Memorial Minority College

Objective :

This policy aims to ensure fair and equitable distribution of scholarships and freeships to students in need, with a focus on physically challenged individuals, economically disadvantaged but meritorious female students, and others who demonstrate financial need.

Guidelines :

- 1) The percentage of students benefited by scholarships will be calculated by dividing the number of scholarship recipients by the total number of eligible college students within a specified timeframe, typically on an annual basis
- 2) A designated percentage of the freeship funds are allocated specifically for physically challenged students Eligibility criteria for physically challenged students will be determined based on verified medical documentation.
- 3) A designated percentage of the total freeship funds are reserved for economically disadvantaged but academically meritorious female students. Eligibility criteria will include income verification and academic performance.
- 4) A portion of the freeship funds will be allocated to provide partial financial assistance to students who do not fall under the physically challenged or economically disadvantaged categories or students who do not receive any scholarships but demonstrate financial need.

The allocation for partial freeships are determined based on available funds and the number of eligible meritorious students.

The college administration establishes a scholarship committee responsible for overseeing the implementation of this policy.
